This is for the information of all concerned that the students admitted to the First Semester of the Four-year B.A./B.Sc. Courses (Honours with or without Research) under the CCF, for the session 2023-24, are hereby instructed to **confirm their choice for MINOR subjects and also choose their IDCs** through the admission portal <https://admission.ladybrabourne.ac.in> .

**Students are required to follow the instructions given below:**

- Students must complete the process of changing and choosing Minor subjects and IDCs within the given window period. **The portal will be open for this on 11.9.23, 12.9.23 and 13.9.23, after which any operation from the student's end will not be allowed.**
- **Students should log in to the portal with their user ID and password.**
- **Students should click on the link for MINOR SUBJECTS, check their Minor subject combination as already given on the portal and confirm the same.** If students want to change the Minor subject combination, they will be able to do it on the portal. Any change in their choice of Minor subjects should be done through the portal.
- Students can confirm/change their AEC 2 (Modern Indian Language) from the same link given for Minor subjects. It is advisable that students should choose any one of Bengali/Hindi/ Urdu as AEC 2.
- Only after confirming/changing of Minor subject combination students will have to give choice for IDCs. It should be noted that after the choice of IDCs are given students should not make any more changes to their Minor choices.
- Students will choose 3 IDCs (3 subjects, different from their Major and Minors, taking 1 subject per semester) from the pool of IDCs offered in the semesters. The choice may be interdisciplinary. **For choosing IDCs, the candidates are required to open the designated link and put their choice of three IDCs for the first 3 semesters.**
- The choice of **Minor subjects and IDCs should comply** with the **approved Minor subject combinations and list of IDCs offered by the college.**
- **It is mandatory for all students to complete the above process to facilitate the process of Registration under the University of Calcutta.**
- The students are required to inform their respective departments if they choose to change their Minor/IDC courses.
- Given below are, the pool of IDCs (semester-wise) and Minor subject combinations offered by the college and students should refer to this list while making their choice:
